





### Prague Jewish Quarter Josefov


The name Josefov comes from the emperor Josef II, whose reforms improved the living conditions for the Jewish people in Prague. The Jewish Quarter lies between the right bank of the Vltava River and the Old Town Square. It contains the remains of Prague's former Jewish ghetto, including its famous cemetery, and a multitude of legends about the mystical Golem and the spirit of Franz Kafka (1883 – 1924).

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
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## AROUND PRAGUE, PART III FROM P. 1

### Vinohrady

The name *Vinohrady* means "vineyards". The area was indeed covered with vineyards starting in the 14th century when Czech king Charles IV had them planted there, right around the time when he had the New Town built. The vineyards lasted for some four hundred years and were later replaced by rose gardens, orchards, and residential buildings.

Vinohrady is now a beautiful, tree-filled residential area of Prague that carries a reputation of prestige and elegance. It covers portions of Prague 2, 3, and 10. Most of its grand Neo-Renaissance, Art Nouveau, Pseudo Baroque, and Neo-Gothic buildings come from the second half of the 19th century and first half of the 20th century, and many have been and continue to be restored in an amazing array of color and architectural detail. *From [www.myczechrepublic.com](http://www.myczechrepublic.com)*



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
