Our Czech Experience

Through the Executive Education programs sponsored and conducted by the International Leadership Institute from 1991 to 2003 (with the US Department of State, the Ministry of Industry and Trade of the Czech Republic, the Jacksonville Chamber of Commerce, and dozens of other government and business partners) and the American English Language Immersion programs from 1991 to the present, we have worked to help people from post-communist countries to regain the values, attitudes, knowledge and skills of a free society that were suppressed during the era of communism.

Spiritual Redemption

"Our civilization cannot survive materially unless it is redeemed spiritually."—1923

These words, spoken by American President Woodrow Wilson (who was instrumental in helping T. G. Masaryk to establish Czechoslovakia following WWI) are aptly applied to our fifteen years of working with Czechs, Slovaks and other people from Central and East Europe.

Our New Vision

Now, with the encouragement and assistance of the Redeemer Family of Churches and Ministries (RFCM), the Communion of



Convergence Churches USA (CCC-USA) and Calvary International, we have a new vision that directly addresses President Wilson's imperative of national spiritual redemption. The CCC-USA is developing a long-term project to plant churches in Europe, beginning in the Czech Republic, making a significant contribution to the reawakening of the Christian soul of the heart of Europe. The Lord has put it in our hearts to spearhead this project. Our vision is to bring the Gospel again to a nation that once led Europe in Christian passion and commitment.

Our Commitment

The Czech Project is committed to helping the Czech nation recover its Christian heritage and build a spiritually awakened society with a strong sense of mission inspired and

led by the example of Jesus Christ, and to planting churches of the CCC-USA (Communion of Convergence Churches USA) throughout the Czech Republic.

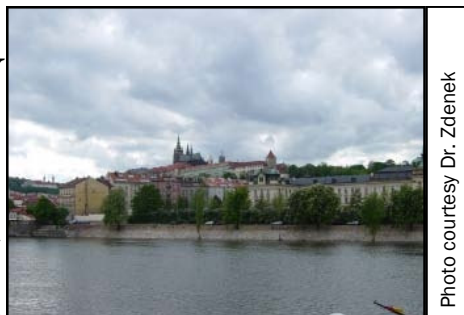
